200+KM CHARITY CYCLE BETWEEN GALWAY AND DUBLIN THIS WEEKEND

220 fundraisers take to the saddle to raise funds for Our Ladies Children's Hospital Crumlin

Who: 220 cyclists with the Laurels Charity Cycle, a fundraising group

What: 200+km cycle over two days between Dublin and Galway

Where

/When: Kick off is opposite Galway Crystal, to Tullamore Central Hotel from 4pm onwards;
Day 2 starts at Tullamore Central Hotel between 9 and 11am with finish at the Laurels Pub, Clondalkin on Sunday at 4pm

220 fit and hardy souls will be opposite Galway Crystal at 7am on Saturday April 21st, starting the 200+km cycle across the country to raise much needed funds for Crumlin Children's Hospital and Straight Ahead the charity which provides free surgeries for children with spinal curvatures or neuromuscular disorders.

The group, known as the Laurels Charity Crew (www.laurelscharitycrew.com) has already raised over €125K for Our Ladies Children's Hospital Crumlin over the last four years.

On Saturday, the cyclists will stop in Craughwell, Portumna, Birr and Kilcormac, finishing day one in Tullamore at the Central Hotel.

Day 2 (Sunday April 22nd) kicks off from the Central hotel in Tullamore, passing through Maynooth and Leixlip, aiming to arrive in the Laurels at 4pm. There will be music from the Clondalkin Youth Band to welcome the cyclists followed by refreshments and celebrations.
